

Hi Kim,

Thank you for your inquiry as to the status of Husky's facilities on the NE 7-50-19 W3M for your upcoming auction.

As identified on the landowner's previous gravel study, there are the following Husky wells and pipelines on that particular quarter:

1. Three abandoned well bores.
2. One abandoned fuel gas line running across the south portion of the quarter and tying in the two southerly well bores.
3. The only active tenure on that quarter is the active pipeline in the very SW corner of the quarter as identified on the attached drawing.

The current gravel extraction activities have worked around the abandoned well bore in the north and we trust that will continue for the two in the south.

As to the abandoned pipeline, Husky would be pleased to work with whomever is extracting gravel on their removal in conjunction with excavation activities.

Under agreement, gravel extraction can take place right up to the pipeline right of way in the southeast corner. One of the conditions of a proximity agreement with Husky will be not to cause geotechnical instability on the right of way.
